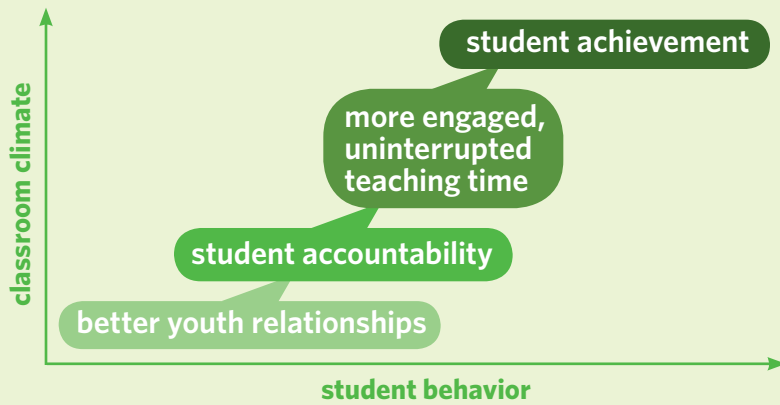

More Youth Leadership Opportunities

Using BIC curriculum consistently helps staff create meaningful opportunities for youth voice, and youth leadership.
